

Orderd Spirits &c to be stored in the County & appearing to the Court that the place where the same is to be kept is suitable and convenient, and that the appearance be a peace of safety, and good character,

In the opinion of James Conwell and five assessors appearing to the County, It is ordered that he be remitted from the payment of Taxes and County Lenes in full, his being a just and informed

In the opinion of Harry Hastings, Esq, and four assessors appearing to the County, It is ordered that he be exempt from the payment of Taxes and County Lenes in full, his being a just and informed

Ordered that C. G. Hartung, D. G. Harmer and J. F. Gosselring be on May and twenty appointed Commissioners to sit in Committee with Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Probate to the said Commissioners to be responsible for returning up the accountings by Daniel John Brandy, receiver the same when completed, and make report to County

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any Consideration thereof in his hands, not otherwise appropriated, pay to Michael Lewis the sum of Two hundred and fifty Eight Pounds, for returning his Black Water Brandy.

Ordered that R. O. Williams be appointed Commissioner to let to the lowest bidder after the bidding up and offering, and paying off account of timber works, the uncut wood built on the West side of Attaway river near Somerton and clearing away from time to time as may be necessary the drift from the several bridges.

The Court did adjudge Sarah P. Remond guardian to Osmond Hall & wife both of age of 18 years & and therewith the together with David H. French & Hall and D. Lamb her trustees (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand and one hundred dollars according to law. It appearing to the court that the value of the estate and personalty of the said wife does not exceed one thousand dollars.

On the motion of James C. Remond who made oath according to law and together with George T. Remond his son (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two thousand dollars conditioned according to law which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted to the said James C. Remond for drawing letters of administration on the estate of Mrs. Hall in the form it being declared that the estate and effects for or in respect of which such letters of administration applied for do not exceed the value of One thousand dollars.

Ordered that John H. Davis, Hall & Bratt, Edward Bratt & D. Lamb or any three of them being first duly sworn for the purpose, to appraise all the goods or chattels of Mrs. Hall and return the same and under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.

On the motion of David H. Remond who made oath according to law and together with David Remond his son (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five hundred dollars conditioned according to law which bond is ordered to be recorded. The said David H. Remond & his son David H. Remond & John D. Remond executors of Mr. J. C. Remond do disgorge payment of the expenses.
