And thereupon the said Olajah Skinner entered into a recognizance in the sum of \$50 with Henry Pelt his security in a like sum conditioned for the appearance of the said Olajah Skinner before the County Court of Southampton County on the first day of March Term next to answer the same and to be and concerning the offence whereunto he stands charged and not to depart without the leave of the said Court.
