

of Sir Thomas Selwyn, Constable as the law directs (the said Selwyn has as
 already stated the accounts and the Court requiring them) and that he is to
 the effect of the said Selwyn's affidavit and duty and that he is to be
 him for the same.

Ordered that J. C. Gifford, A. S. Gifford, Burgess H. Gifford & G. H. Gifford, (or any
 three of them) being first duly sworn for the purpose, do appraise and the goods &
 chattels of Robert C. Gifford, that may be pertinent to them, and any real estate which
 the estate is authorized to sell, or of which he is authorized, to receive the rents and
 profits, and return the appraisements under their hands to the Clerk of the Court.

The Court doth assign Samuel D. Portner, Guardian of Walter D. Sumner's
 Affairs of W. D. Sumner's do. and thereupon the said Samuel D. Portner,
 entered into a bond in the penalty of Walter Sumner's do. according
 to law, with J. C. Gifford his security, wherein, who posted in cash as to his
 sufficiency, and which said bond being acknowledged by the obligors therein in
 presence of a Stamp of the Inferior Revenue of the amount of \$1.00 affixed thereto and
 duly executed is ordered to be recorded.

The Court doth assign J. D. Portner, Guardian of the person and estate of
 W. D. Sumner's do. and thereupon the said J. D. Portner, entered into a bond in the penalty
 of Walter Sumner's do. according to law, with Samuel D.
 Portner his security, wherein, who posted in cash as to his sufficiency,
 and which said bond being acknowledged by the obligors therein in
 presence of a Stamp of the Inferior Revenue of the amount of \$1.00
 affixed thereto and duly executed, is ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the account of Mr. Henry S. Steward, Factor of the County, amount-
 ing to \$99.75 be referred to the Auditor of Public accounts for his exam-
 ination and payment.

Ordered that the account of Mr. Henry S. Steward, Factor of the County, amount-
 ing to five dollars and fifty cents be referred to the Auditor of Public accounts for his
 examination and payment. It being provided to the Court that immediately after
 the Commandant of the said Henry Jones, the Lieutenant, and is sent over in every two
 weeks thereafter, application was made to the Board of Directors of both
 companies for admission, and that such application, was refused for want of room.

On the Motion of Mr. Henry S. Steward to keep an Ordinance and select liquor, of the
 said Henry Jones & others, and to keep a house for them to select liquor & it is
 ordered that the Court being satisfied that they are persons of Sobriety
 and good character, and that the same place where the same is to be held
 is fit and convenient.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
