

Boundaries of Townships in Southampton County.

Township of Drewsville. Commences at Carys Bridge, thence to Bethlehem brog Roads thence to Long type, thence to Norfolk St Bridge, thence to Smiths Harris thence to Halyes bridge thence to Johnsonville line, and the road from Carys Bridge to Halyes bridge described in above boundary shall belong to Township of Drewsville.

Places of Registration & voting. Drewsville and Green Plain Store Registrar. W. P. Clements.

Township of Baylins. Commences at Carys bridge. Following boundaries of Drewsville Township to Halyes bridge, on one side down N. H. way River to the Bridge at Jerusalem, thence along Bradfords Road to Hays, Tugwons, thence to Criskeys, thence down Fish Road, to Piney brook, thence along Browns Bridge Road to North Carolina line. Places of Registration & Voting. Baylins Depot and Oak Grove. The Roads from Jerusalem Bridge to Criskeys belong to the Township. Registrar. E. B. Benton.

Township of Newsoms Depot. Follows the boundary of Baylins Depot Township to North Carolina line thence along said line to Anthony River, thence up said River to the beginning at the Bridge of Jerusalem. The road running from Criskeys to Piney brook thence to North Carolina, on the Bone Bridge Road, belongs to this Township. Places of Registration & Voting. Newsoms Depot & Taynors Store. Registrar. Orman M. Bryant.

Township of Franklin. Commences at Cypress bridge, thence up to the Road between Piney brook and the Holles, across Flaggys Run, by N. H. way Church to Taynors bridge, and all south of the Road, between the two Rivers Anthony and Blackwater, the Road between Cypress bridge and Taynors bridge, shall belong to this Township. Place of Registration & voting. Franklin. Registrar. Luther R. Edwards.

Township of Jerusalem. Commences at Cypress bridge, running with the boundary of Franklin Township to Taynors bridge thence up Black water to Blackwater bridge, thence by the reading by Allen Edwards & Alfred Stephens to the widow Gallis Edwards, thence up the road to the widow Irving Griffiths, thence up the road to the Jerusalem & Smithfield road thence up the Smithfield road to Violets thence up the Carys Bridge road to Sellers Sign board thence to J. & A. Parkmans thence to the Appamont bridge, thence up the branch to the Chapel line thence along the Sulphur line to Anthony River and down said River to Cypress bridge. The Road from Blackwater bridge to the Appamont bridge in the above boundaries shall belong to the above Township. Places of voting & Registration. Jerusalem & Black Creek Church. Registrar. J. A. Seabell.

Township of Berlin & Ivor. Commences at Blackwater bridge, thence along the line of the Township of Jerusalem, to the Sulphur line, thence along the Sulphur line to the Curry line, and along the Curry line to Blackwater River and thence and thence to Blackwater bridge. Places of Voting & Registration. Berlin and Ivor. Registrar. Samuel T. Drury. Done in Jerusalem this 21st day of April A.D. 1870. Given under our hands the day above written.
