

Boundaries of Townships in Southampton County.

Township of Duryville. Commences at Cangs Bridge, thence to Bothelton Cross Roads, thence to Long Lane, thence to North East Ponds, thence to Newell Harris, thence to Haly's Bridge, thence to Gravelly Line, and the road from Cangs Bridge to Haly's Bridge described in above boundary shall belong to Township of Duryville.

Places of Registration & voting - Duryville and Green Haven Store. Registrar - W. P. Clements.

Township of Boykins. Commences at Cangs bridge, Following boundaries of Duryville Township to Haly's Bridge, one side down Nottoway River back Bridge at Jerusalem, thence along Bridgeford Road to Hwy. Tugnutt, thence to Cogkeys, thence down Fish Road, to Pisgah Creek, thence along Brown's Bridge Road to North Carolina line. Places of Registration & Voting - Boykins Depot and Oak Grove. The Roads from Jerusalem Bridge to Cogkeys belong to the Township. Registrar - E. B. Benton.

Township of Newsoms Depot. Follows the boundary of Boykins Depot Township to North Carolina line thence along said line to Nottoway River, thence up said River to the beginning of the Bridge of Concord. The road running from Cogkeys to Pisgah Creek thence to North Carolina, on the Beams Bridge Road belongs to the Township. Places of Registration & Voting - Newsoms Depot & Dogers Store. Registrar - Orman W. Bryant.

Township of Franklin. Commences at Cypress Bridge, thence up to the Road between Bay Berwicks and New Hobbs, across Flaggby Run, by Nottoway Church to Dogers Bridge, and all south of the Road between the two Rivers Nottoway and Blackwater, the Road between Cypress Bridge and Dogers Bridge, shall belong to this Township. Place of Registration & voting - Franklin. Registrar - Luther R. Edwards.

Township of Jerusalem. Commences at Cypress Bridge, running with the boundary of Franklin Township to Dogers Bridge, thence up Blackwater to Blackwater Bridge, thence by the reading by Allen Edwards & Alfred Richardson to the widow Sallie Edwards, thence up the road to the Union Spring Ciffes, thence up the road to the Jerusalem & Smithfield road, thence up said Smithfield road to Vickville, thence up the Barry's Bridge road to Bellers, sign board thence to J. D. & W. Barnes, thence to the Apamericick Bridge, thence up the branch to the Cypress line, thence along the Cypress line to Nottoway River and down said River to Cypress Bridge. The Road from Blackwater Bridge to the Apamericick Bridge in the above boundaries shall belong to the above Township. Places of voting & Registration - Jerusalem & Black Bank Church. Registrar - J. A. Schell.

Township of Berlin & Ivor. Commences at Blackwater Bridge, thence along the line of the Township of Jerusalem, to the Cypress line, thence along the Cypress line to the Survey line, and along the Survey line to Blackwater River and thence up thence to Blackwater Bridge. Places of Voting & Registration - Berlin and Ivor. Registrar - Samuel E. Drury. Done in Jerusalem this 21st day of April A.D. 1870. Given under our hands the day above written.
