Court.

Upon the Petition of Benjamin Simmons Admonr of
John Simmons doct against Thomas Scarborough for one pound
nine Shillings & four pence due by Account. This Day Came
the Parties who being fully heard It is Ordered that the said
Petition be Dismissed.

Upon the Petition of Benjamin Simmons Admonr of
John Simmons doct against Jonas Matthews for one
pound eighteen Shillings & eight pence due by Account
This Day Came the Parties who being fully heard It is
Ordered that the said Petition be Dismissed and that the
Defendant pay unto the Plaintiff his Costs in this behalf
expended.

Upon the Petition of Benjamin Simmons Admonr of John
Simmons doct against Thomas Frances for three pounds
fifteen Shillings & four pence due by Account This Day Came
as well the Plaintiff by his Attorney as the Defendant in his proper
Person who produced an Account against the Estate of the
Plaintiff's Intestate for two pounds four Shillings & four pence
which he proved by his own Oath & was allowed by the Court
Therefore this Court doth that the Plaintiff recover against
the said Defendant the sum of one pound eleven Shillings
the third part of the said Debt and her Costs by him in this
behalf expended.
