William Whitehead & described his Name as a Witness thereto

for obtaining a Probate thereof in due form giving security
whereupon he together with Thomas Jarnell & Honell Edmonds
his Security entered into & acknowledged their Bond for the
said Lewis due & faithful Administration of the said ^{deceased's} Estate
& performance of his Will.

John Piper or any three of them being first sworn Honell
Edmonds Gent do Appraise in Fabrics Money the Laves &
Personal Estate of Arthur Whitehead dec'd & return the
Appraisement to the Court.

decd was returned & is Ordered to be Recorded.

An Indenture of Bargain & Sale between John Windham of
the one part and John Hull of the other part and a Memorandum
of Every of them thereon endorsed were proved by the Oath of
John Adams a Witness thereto and the same having been
before proved by the Oath of two other of the Witnesses are
Ordered to be Recorded.
