An Indenture of Settlement between Joseph Newsum and Jacob Pope of the one part and Stephen Pope of the other part and an Memorandum of delivery & receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the Oaths of William Pope & John Pope two of the Witnesses thereto

Ordered that the Court be adjourned 'till the Court in June & the Minutes of these proceedings were Signed J. Gray
