Test and took the Oath of a Justice of the Peace and Judge
in Chancery which were also Administered to him by the
said Benj Simmons & Peter Butts And then the said John
Brown Administered all the said Oaths to Nathaniel Ridley
Thomas Jarrell Peter Butts & Benjamin Simmons which
they took and jointly subscribed the said Abjuration Oath
and Test
