Thursday the 11.<sup>th</sup> Day of July 1751.

A Commission of the Peace and Dedimus from the Mouth  
the President under the Seal of this Colony bearing Date the  
eleventh Day of June last past directed to John Brown &  
others were produced & read Whereupon pursuant to the said  
Dedimus John Brown had the Oaths appointed by Act of  
Parliament to be taken instead of the Oaths of Allegiance  
and Supremacy the Abjuration Oath and Test Administered  
to him by Benjamin Simmons & Peter Butts which he  
took and then subscribed the said last mentioned Oaths and  
Test and took the Oath of a Justice of the Peace and Judge  
in Chancery which were also Administered to him by the  
said Beny Simmons & Peter Butts And then the said John  
Brown administered all the said Oaths to Nathaniel Ridley  
Thomas Jarrell Peter Butts & Benjamin Simmons which  
they took and severally subscribed the said Abjuration Oath  
and Test
