the Court that he forfeit & pay unto the Churchwardens
of the Parish of Nantoway five Shillings or fifty pence
of Tobacco & the Costs of this Prosecution.

Newsum Senr for profane Swearing. The said Robert Newsum
having been duly summoned not now appearing or offering
any thing in Pledge It is Considered by the Court that
he forfeit & pay unto the Churchwardens of the Parish
