from the Mouth of the said Creek Road to the  
said Javelle Plantation the Road leading along or  
near a Path called a new Path And that the said Road  
will not be prejudicial to any Persons Land except  
Timothy Sharp & John Fort and not any way but will  
be to them Given under our Hands this 12<sup>th</sup> Day of  
September 1751 Henry Vaughan. Lieutenant Governor  
of Province. Whereupon It is Ordered that a new Road  
between Javelle & Grafton's Branchway be made according to law  
as in the said Report is mentioned which Timothy Sharp  
& John Fort are appointed to see performed And It is  
further Ordered that this said Road be kept in repair  
thereof and that he with the said Labouring Citizens  
of Fowey Bay & Oldbridge Taylor at Buckhorn Quarter  
Timothy Sharp John Fort Frost Barnes John Denney  
to Open & keep the said Road according to law

John Brown Esq & Benjamin Johnson who were  
secretly appointed to agree with Workmen for building  
a Bridge over Notomay Swamp at the Charge of the  
County this Day made their Report in the Words Mf  
smt. Agreeable to the written Order we have agreed  
with William Speed to build a Bridge fifteen feet Long and  
according to Law to keep the same in good Repair the  
Term of seven Years from the last of November next  
paying for his pounds ten shillings of his penal

Ordered that the Bridge over the Angelica swamp be  
rebuilt at the Charge of the County and that Richard  
Ridley Timothy Sharp & James Jones do contract and  
agree with Workmen to perform the same & make up  
the cost to the fourt
