disputed Land be divided & surveyed by a surveying to law
in the said Report is mentioned which Timothy Tharp
& John Fort are appointed to see performed And It is
further Ordered that Elias Fort be appointed Overseer
hereof and that he with the Male labouring Settlers
of Joseph Gray Charles Taylor at Buckhorn Quarter
Timothy Tharp John Fort Jacob Barnes John Demory
to open & keep the said Road according to law

Richard Harty jun^r & Charles Cooky who were appointed
Inspectors of the said ^{at the last Court} Road appeared this Day &
were sworn according to law

Joseph Brown Gent^l & Benjamin Johnson who were
heretofore appointed to agree with Workmen for building
a Bridge over Neckway Swamp at the Charge of the
County this Day made their Report in the Words fol-
lowing. Agreeable to the within Order we have agreed
with William Price to build a Bridge fifty feet long and
according to law & to keep the same in good Repair the
Term of seven Years from the last of November next
commencing for the bounds ten Shillings & Six pence
August 27 1701. Joseph Brown Benⁿ Johnson

Ordered that the Bridge over the Neckway Swamp be
Rebuilt at the Charge of the County and that Nathaniel
Bidley Timothy Tharp & James Jones do Contract and
agree with Workmen to perform the same & make up
thereof to the Court
