This Day came the Plaintiff by Miles Cary and his Attorney and the said Defendant being called to find Special Bail failing so to do it is Ordered that he be committed to the Gaol of the County for Debtor And the said Defendant now in Custody as aforesaid came into Court and acknowledged the Plaintiff's Action for eight pounds current Money due Debt in the Declaration mentioned Therefore it is Considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover against the said Defendant the said eight pounds plus his Costs by him in this behalf expended But this Judgment except as to the Costs is to be discharged by the payment of four pounds together with Interest for the same to be computed after the Rate of five per centum per Annum from the Third Day of September 1747 to the Time of Payment And the body of the said Defendant is to remain in Custody as aforesaid until the Execution of this Judgment be had
