An Indenture of Leffment between Edward Barnes of the one part and George Summerville of the other part and a Memorandum of Inventory theron endorsed were acknowledged by the said Edward and Ordered to be Recorded, and Elizabeth the wife of the said Edward Barnes personally appeared in Court and being first Privily examined as the law directs Voluntarily relinquished her Right of Dower in the Estate Conveyed by the said Indenture.

Ordered that Peter Butts Gent be appointed to take a List of the Pethables in this County from Nottoway River along Surry County line to the Roanoke Swamp from thence to the three Creeks flowing down them to Smiths Bridge up the Chappel Road to the old Parish Line thence to the River for the ensuing Year.
