Upon the Petition of Alldigton Jones Gent who is the Owner & Proprietor of a Water Grind Mill on Netterway Swamp in this County through Ignorance or Mistake hath not exactly followed the Method prescribed by Law when such Mill was built in respect to an Acre of Land adjoining It is Ordered that Thomas Jarrell & Peter Butts Gent do Value an Acre of Land opposite and adjoining to the said Mill according to the Act of Assembly without having regard to any of the adjacent Lands affected by such Mill that they make Report thereof to the Court.

Ordered that the Sheriff in Company with the Surveyor of this County do lay off ten Acres of Land adjoining to the Prison of this County for the Bound of the said Prison And that the said Surveyor do return a Plot of such Survey to this Court.
