Upon the Petition of John Ruffin against Benjamin Hardin for three pounds and one penny due by Account This Day Came the Plaintiff by his Attorney and the Defendants having been duly summoned & served with a Copy of the Petition and Account and not appearing On the Motion of the said Plaintiff whose Account was proved by his own Oath It is Considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover against the said Defendant the said three pounds and one penny and his Costs by him in this behalf expended with a Lawyers fee.
