Upon the Petition of John Ruffin against Benjamin Horden in three pounds and one penny due by Account This Day Came the Plaintiff by his Attorney and the Defendant having been duly Summons served with a copy of the Petition and Answers and not appearing On the Motion of the said Plaintiff whose Account was proved by his own Oath It is Considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover against the said Defendant the said three pounds and one penny and his Costs by him in this behalf expended with a Lawyer fee

William Johnson having obtained an Attachment against the Estate of Unity Matthew who hath privately removed himself or so absconds that the ordinary process cannot be served on her for one pound ten shillings due to the said William Joseph Gray, Gray Genl Sheriff of this County now made return that he had delivered Specied the said Attachment in the hands of Nathaniel Ridley Garnisher of Newell Unity This Day Came the said William and the said Nathaniel Ridley appeared being first sworn deposed that he hath in his hands of the Estate of Newell Unity the sum of One pound ten shillings Therefor on the Motion of the said William it is proved his Demand to be paid by his own Oath It is Considered by the Court that the said William recover against the said Unity the said One pound ten shillings and his Costs by him in this behalf expended And It is Ordered that the said Garnisher Deliver the Money in his hands as aforesaid to the said William to satisfaction of their judgment.
