Day came the Parties and the Defendant saith that he cannot
gainay the Allegation of the said Petition. Therefore it is Considered
that the Plaintiff recover against the said Defendant the sum of
three pounds eight shillings pence this 6th by him
in this behalf appeared.

George Delt having obtained an Attachment against the Estate of
Thomas Jones who hath privately removed himself or so absconded that
the Ordinary process of Law cannot be served on him for a Debt due
to the said George. Joseph Gray Esq. Sheriff of this County now
made return that he had attached One horse and a Woman's saddle
and Bridle of the Estate of the said Thomas. This Day came the said
George who proved his Demand of one pound ten shillings and
four pence to be just by his own Oath as did the said Thomas not
now appearing to reply the said Attached effects. It is Considered
by the Court that the said George recover against the said Thomas
the said One pound ten shillings pence this 6th by him
in this behalf appeared. And it is Ordered that the Sheriff sell
the said Attached Effects at Public Auction for ready money and
therewith discharge this Judgment and so much thereof as the
Sale shall amount to and the Cost of this Suit and that he
return an Account of his proceedings to the next Court.

The Person appointed to View the Courthouse of this County now
made Report that the Undertaker thereof had not built finished
the same according to his Agreement entered into with the Justices
of this County. Therefore it is Ordered that a Suit be commenced
by the said Contracting Justices against the said Undertaker on his
Agreement aforesaid.
