On Application for a Bridge to be built over the three Creeks at the cleared from Surry County down to the three Creek Road it is Ordered that Timothy Thorpe, James Jones and John Myrick be being first sworn faithfully & impartially to perform the service do view the lands whereon the said Road & Bridge are proposed to be cleared & report to the Court the Conveniences and inconveniences thereof.
