This day came the plaintiff his attorney and the
said Defendant acknowledged the plaintiffs action for
the principal sum interest and charges of protest in
the bill of exchange in the declaration mentioned therefore
It is considered by the court that the plaintiffs recover
against the said Defendant twenty eight pounds two
shillings and five pence sterling twenty pounds part
thereof being the principal sum in the said bill
of exchange mentioned seven pounds sixteen shillings
and eight pence being interest for the said principal sum
computed after the rate of ten centum per annum
from the twenty fifth day of October 1788. to this
day and five shillings and nine pence the residue being
the charges of protest in the said declaration mentioned
and that the plaintiffs recover against the said Defendant
interest on the aforesaid twenty eight pounds two
shillings and five pence sterling to be computed after
the rate of five per centum per annum from this day
to the time of payment and their costs by them about
their suit in this behalf expended and the said
Defendant in money &c.
