On the motion of John Porter a witness for
Etheldred Taylor against John Ingrams It is
Ordered that the said Taylor pay here fifty pounds
of neat tobacco for two days attendance on this court
according to law

Phillips Jones who was heretofore committed for
failing to give security for the indemnification
of the parish for the maintenance of a bastard child
and it being again demanded of him and he again
failing so to do is committed to the Gaol of this
county untill he shall find such security
Ordered that the court be adjourned till the court
in course

At a court held for the county of Southampton on
Thursday the 12 day of October 1794 Nath Ridley
the parish of Howell & Sanders Abington & the Parishes
in the custody and apprehension of the estate of
Benjamin Johnson (decd) was returned ordered to
be awarded

Penney a negro boy belonging to Benjamin Barrow
is by the court adjudged to eight years of age

For reasons appearing to the court William Hickson
is exempt from paying public slavery tax.

Hannah a negro girl belonging to Elias Foster is by
the adjudged to twelve years of age.

An indenture of apprenticeship between William Horn
and Sarah his wife of the one part and Benjamin
Horton of the other part was acknowledged by the
said William Horn and Sarah his wife after the being
first sworn examined as the law directs and the
memorandum of laws of justice thereon ordered
was acknowledged by the said Horton and he the
said indenture ordered to be awarded
