and one penny farthing to the plaintiff Thomas
Holt in right of the said Ann his wife the sum
of eleven pounds five shillings and one penny farthing
and to the plaintiff Thomas Brown in right of the
said Margaret his wife the sum of eleven pounds
five shillings and one penny farthing that the
said defendant pay costs.
