down above four months at any one time after the
finishing thereof within the said term of ten years
the term of the ten years is to begin at the time of
finishing the bridge and the said Thomas Langley
is to have five pounds for each year that the said
bridge shall stand and be kept in good repair after
the ten years shall be expired given under our hands
this 15th day of December 1752.
