Report concerning the Court house lands was this day made & is in the words following. In Obedience to an order of the court of Southampton County bearing date the 24th day of January last past we have viewed the two acres of land wherein the court house prison pillory whipping post & stocks belonging to the said county are situate & in the said order particularly mentioned & do report that the true value thereof is two pounds three shillings & sixpence under our hands & seals this eighth day of February 1753
