The arbitrators to whom the difference between the parties
 was referred to this day make their award and is in
 the words following to wit, "In Obedience to an order
 of the court of the county of Southampton bearing date
 the eighth day of March instant we the subscribers
 being hereby appointed to determine all matters in
 difference in an action of trespass quare clausum fregit
 and pending in the court of the said county between
 Richard Pond plf and Benjamin Clifton Def have this
 day heard the said parties and the evidence to us put in
 on considering whereof we are of opinion that the deft
 is guilty of the trespass in the destruction of the plts
 cornfield and that the plaintiff hath sustained
 damage by occasion thereof to forty shillings besides his
 costs And we do accordingly award and order that the
 defendant pay the said sum of forty shillings to the
 plaintiff together with his costs by him about his
 suit in this behalf expended given under our hands
 this twenty second day of March 1753. in the 23rd year
 of the reign of our sovereign lord King George the first
