 county now made return that he had attached one hoghead of Tobacco
 eight head of cattle and a horse and both of the estate of the said
 Ralph Carter This appearance the said Richard Richs who proved
 his demand of five pounds nine shillings and eight pence to be
 just by his own oath Therefore it is considered by the court that the
 sheriff sell the said attached effects and therewith discharge the
 aforesaid debt or commit things as the sale shall amount to and
 costs of this suit and that he also return an account of his receiving
 to the next court
