This day came the parties by their attorneys and thereupon came also a jury to wit, Henry Gafford Benjamin Lewis William Biddle Henry Applewhaite Lachson Newson Thomas Brown Joseph Newson John Kirby Jacob Williams Thomas Williams, Richard Bond & Isaac Johnson who being called to aid and sworn the truth to speak upon the oaths joined upon their oath do say that the defendant did assure upon himself in manner and form as the plaintiff against him hath complained and they do assess the plaintiffs damage by occasion thereof to fifty four pounds ten shillings and six pence besides his costs therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said fifty four pounds ten shillings and six pence and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in mercy

A Letter of Attorney from William Jeffries to William Hodson was on the motion of Jeph Brown & Albington Jones advs &c of Charles Portlock cited Ordine to be recorded Jeph Brown gent presented a commission from the Honble the Lieutenant Governor to be Sheriff of this county during pleasure and thereupon he together with James Ridley & Albington Jones entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of £1000 firsting according to law and then the said Jeph having first taken the usual oaths to his Majesty person and Government and taken and subscribed the abjuration oath and test was sworn Sheriff of this county
