Upon the petition of Thomas Eldridge against James Puley for four pounds eight shillings and six pence half penny due by account This day came as well the said plaintiff by his attorney as the said defendant in his proper person and the said plaintiff confessing the allegation of the said petition to be true It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said four pounds eight shillings and six pence half penny and his costs by him in this behalf expended with a Lawyers fee.

Upon the petition of James Ray and Howell Briggs against George for four pounds fifteen shillings and eight pence due by bill This day came as well the plaintiff by their attorney as the defendant in his proper person and the said defendant saith he cannot gainsay the allegation of the said petition Therefore It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said four pounds fifteen shillings and eight pence and his costs by him in this behalf expended with a Lawyers fee But this judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of two pounds seven shillings and ten pence together with interest for the same to be computed after the rate of five percent upon annum from the twenty fifth day of October 1752 to the day of payment.
