pay her one hundred pounds of new tobacco for one day
attendance on this court and traveling twenty five miles
and returning according to law.

Ordered that the sheriff summon twenty four of the
most capable persons, being freeholders, not being ordinary
supers or jurors or occupiers of mills or highways of highway
to appear at Townshend court next to be sworn a grand
inquest on the body of this country.
