The last will and testament of John Rutledge was proved by the oaths of William Byrnum a witness thereto the same having been heretofore proved and ordered to be recorded And His Order that the widow of the testator be summoned to declare whether she will administer on the said husbands estate with the will annexed there being no executor named therein

Benzamen Welden produced a commission from the president and Masters of the College of William & Mary appointing him a justice surveyor of this county and the said Benjamin Welden having first taken the usual oaths to his Majesty's person and government and taken and subscribed the abjuration oath of test was accordingly sworn a justice surveyor

Ordered that the churchwardens of the parish of Northwell bind out a Mabelle Child of Ann Woods and Ann's poor child of Richard Byrnum and Lucetta Davis about two child of Patience Davis according to law
