The defendant not appearing on the motion of the plaintiff by his attorney It is ordered that the conditional judgment obtained against him and John Little his surety be confirmed for one hundred and twenty seven pounds five shillings and nine pence Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover agst the said defendant the said one hundred and twenty seven pounds five shillings and nine pence and his costs by them about their suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in mercy &c But this judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of sixty one pound eleven shillings and two pence halfpenny together with interest for the same to be computed after the rate of five per centum per annum from the 10 day of January 1753 to the time of payment.
