It is ordered that the said Drury and Jane pay them respectively
one hundred and fifty pounds of net wages for six days
attendance on the court according to law

On the motion of Jeph Harris a witness for Drury Byrnum &
Jane his wife against Thomas Atherton It is ordered that the
said Drury and Jane pay him one hundred of twenty five
