

This day came the parties by their attorneys and the defendant withdrawing his former plea acknowledged the plaintiff's action for the debt in the declaration mentioned. Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against said defendant thirty eight pounds three shillings and three pence the debt agreed and her costs by him about her suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in money. But this judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of nineteen pounds one shilling seven pence half pence together with interest for the same to be computed after the rate of five per centum per annum for the 3 day of September 1750 to the time of payment.
