the said road according to law

An indenture of settlement between Samuel Bayhie of the
one part and John Bayhie of the other part and the more
particulars of slavery of such slaves theron endorsed were acknowledge
by the said Samuel and ordered to be recorded and saved.
The wife of the said Samuel personally appeared in court being
first properly examined as the law directs voluntarilie relinquishing
her right of service in the estate conveyed thereby
An Inventory of the estate of John Johnson died was
returned and ordered to be recorded
