pounds and his costs by him in this behalf expended
and the said defendant may be taken off.

James Whitehead appeared and entered into bond with
security for prosecuting his appeal from a judgment of this
court obtained by Joseph Gold agt the said Lewis
on the motion of Benjamin Brooks a witness for Sylvanus
Staniton at the suit of John Little. It is ordered that the
said Sylvanus pay him two hundred and forty eight
pounds of rest wages for two days attendance and traveling
thirty three miles time and returning.
