The persons appointed to lay of and open a road from near Round Hill to near George Woods now made report that the same is performed Therefore it is ordered that the bonds of M^r Henry Broome at round hill and the old indian town George Wood Leonard Oney Richardson Riggan Stephen Simons Samuel Blon Richard Telle and William Exum do repair and keep the said road according to law And Stephen Simons is by the court appointed surveyor thereof to see the same performed
