John Little It is Ordered that the said William pay him
three hundred and sixty five pounds of rest tobacco for five
days attendance on this court and traveling twenty miles from
and returning

This day came as well the plaintiff by his attorney
as the defendants in their proper persons and the said defendants
acknowledged the plaintiffs action for forty six pounds fifteen
shillings and two pence half penny besides his costs Therefore

said defendant the said forty six pounds fifteen shilling and
two pence half penny and his costs by him about his suit
in this behalf expended But this judgment except as to the
costs is to be discharged by the payment of twenty three pound
seven shillings and seven pence farthing together with interest
for the same to be computed after the rate of five per centum
per annum from the 13th day of February 1751. to the time of
payment and the said defendant in money &c
