This day came the parties by their attorneys and thereupon came also a jury to wit William Vick Arthur Vick Nathan Harwood Simon Turner Moses Phillips Bernamen Vapor Thomas Chapple John Underwood Bernamen Prossman George Gurley Mr Thomas Moore and Drury Davis who being elected tried and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue joined upon their oath do say that the defendant doth not owe the debt in the declaration mentioned as in pleading he hath alledged Therefore It is Considered by the court that the plaintiff take nothing by his bill but for his false clamour be in mercy &c And the defendant go thereof ^{without day} and recover agst the said plaintiff his costs by him about his defence in this behalf expended

An indenture of feoffment between Arthur Taylor of the one part and Thomas Turner of the other part and the memorandum of livery of seisin thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Arthur and ordered to be recorded and Faith the wife of the said Arthur personally appeared in court and being first fully examined as the law directs voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the estate conveyed thereby

An indenture of feoffment between Bernamen Jenkens of the one part and Spencer Jenkens of the other part and the memorandum of livery of seisin thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Bernamen Jenkens and ordered to be recorded
