

they have alleged and they do app^r the plaintiffs damages by reason thereof to one penny besides his costs Therefore It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover ag^t the said defendant two hundred pounds the debt in the declaration mentioned and his damages app^r said in form afores^d app^red and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended But this judgment except as to the damages and costs is to be discharged by the payment of one hundred pounds together with interest for the same to be computed after the rate of five per centum per annum from the 11 day of August 1752. to the time of payment and the said defendant in mercy &c
