Robert Piche having obtained an attachment agt the estate of Richard Mounford who hath privately removed himself so as absconds that the ordinary process of law cannot be served on him for six pounds four shillings and eleven pence half penny due by account Samuel Blorgent Sheriff of this county now made return that he had attached all the said Richard Mounford in the hands of Richard Kirby jun his guarriphee This day came the said Robert Piche and the said Richard Kirby jun the guarriphee having been duly summoned appeared and being first sworn deposed that he hath in his hands of the estate of the said Richard a Carpenters square a chest lock and the bottom of an ink glass Therefore on the motion of the said Robert who proved his demand to be just according to law It is Considered by the court that the said Robert recover agt the said Richard the said six pounds four shillings and eleven pence half penny & his costs by turn in this behalf expended And It is Ordered that the said guarriphee deliver the said effects to the sheriff of this county and that the sheriff sell the same at public auction for ready money and therewith discharge the aforesaid debt for so much thereof as the sale shall amount to and costs of this suit And that he also return an account of his proceedings hereing to the next court
