

At a Court held for the county of Southampton on
Thursday the 11th day September 1765.

Present Horrell Edwards James Ridley

Ordered that the sheriff summon twenty four of the
most capable persons of this county to appear here
at the next court and be sworn a Grand Jury of inquirers
on the body of this county

Ordered that the vestry of the parish of Rottonway
do divide their parish into precincts for prosuoroning every
persons land and appoint the particular time between
the last day of September and the last day of March the
next following and also appoint two or more intelligent
honest freeholders to see such prosuoroning performed
and make report to the vestry agreeable to the act
of assize

Now a negro belonging to Pubuca Fort having been brought
committed to the goal of this county on a breach of the
peace was brought into court and Joshua Lewis
requiring security of the peace agt him and having
taken the usual oath It is Ordered that the said
negro find security for his good behaviour in the sum
of fifty pounds for the space of twelve months and on
failure thereof that he be committed to the goal until
he find such security which may be returned into
before the sheriff

On the motion of Martha Jarrell guardian to Thomas
Jarrells orphans time is allowed her till the next
court to make up and return her accounts of her
guardianship of the said orphans estate
