freedom and whether in his opinion she is entitled thereto
and that the said Clark do not refuse her on this account

On the Motion of Miles Cary who was an attorney for several
defendants at the suit of Richard Harnden [which suit
was dismissed for want of prosecution] that the clerk
might tax a Carrys fee for each defendant in the said
suits in the bill of costs is overruled by the court
and ordered that the clerk tax but one fee in each of
the said suits
