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his suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in money
But this judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged
by the payment of forty two pence together with interest for the
same to be computed after the rate of five per centum per annum
from the 10 day of January last past to the time of payment of
the plaintiff acknowledged satisfaction for seven pence eight shillings
and three pence in part of the above judgment & agrees to stay
execution three months for the residue

Upon the petition of William Scott & Joseph Scott endorsees of
✓ ^{Erasmus Scott} ^{deced} agt John Adams for one pound eleven shillings
and seven pence
half pence due by account This day came ^{as well} the plaintiff by his
