county line & down the flat swamp to the old parish
line.

Ordered that Peter Butts take the list of tithes where -
William Taylor did last year and the said Taylor in
the precinct of the said Butts.

Ordered that the court be adjourned till the court in course

At a Court held at the Courthouse of Southampton county
the 29th day of April 1756 on the examination of Richard
Riches on suspicion of the murder of one Phillip Morgan
Present Howell Edmunds of others

The above named Richard Riches being committed
to the goal of this county charged with the Murder aforesaid
