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An indenture of feoffment between Hugh Basden of the
one part John Weather of the other part and the
memorandum of livery of seisin thereon endorsed were ack-
nowledged by the said Hugh and ordered to be recorded
and Mary the wife of the said Hugh personally appeared
in court and being first lawfully examined as the law
directs voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the
estate conveyed by the said indenture

The last will and testament of John Davis was presented
in court by Mary Stewart one of the executors therein
named proved by the oaths of Thomas Percell and James Ridgely
the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and On the
petition of the said executors who made oath according to law
certificate is granted her for obtaining a probat thereof in due
form giving security reprobation with Thomas
Moore her security entered into and acknowledged their bond with
penalty of five hundred pounds for the said Marys due and
faithful adon of the said deceders estate and performance
of his will

Ordered that Timothy Thorpe James Jones John Myrick and
Nevitt Dren or any three of them being first sworn before a
justice of the peace do appraise in current money the lands
if any and personal estate of John Dren decd and return the
appraisement to the court
