 shery of this county now made return that he had executed the said attachment in the hands of Robert Richs & William Scott and that he had summoned them as garnishees This day came the said Simon Turner and the said Robert Richs appeared and being first sworn deposed that he had nothing in his hands of the estate of the said Richard Therefore On the Motion of the said Simon It is Considered by the court that he sum against the said Richard the said fifty two pounds ten shillings together with interest for the same to be computed after the rate of five per centum per annum for the twenty ninth day of March 1755 to the time of payment This costs by him in this behalf

On the Motion of Charles Barkham a witness for Benjamin Heale against Holliday Fort It is Ordered that the said Benjamin pay him fifty pounds of neat tobacco for two days attendance at this court according to law
