Henry Thomas guardian to Eley and John Jewells orphans of Thomas Jewell deceased returned his accounts of the said orphans estates to which he made oath and the same were examined and approved of by the court and ordered to be recorded

An indenture of Joynment between Benjamin Clifton of the one part of Thomas Clifton of the other part was acknowledged by the said Benjamin and ordered to be recorded

Ordered that the sheriff for the year 1753 and 1754 account with the treasurer for the balance of tobacco due to the county at the rate the same sold for on an average for those years

Upon the petition of Robert Caonichael against John Calthorpe for two pounds three shillings and one penny half penny due by account this day came the said Robert by his attorney and the defendant having been duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and account and not appearing On the Motion of the said plaintiff It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said two pounds three shillings and one penny half penny and his costs by him in this behalf expended with a lawyers fee

The petition of Stephen Pope Esq Robert Vick and Simon Barrett is continued till the next court
