Ordered that Robert Carr John Lee James Basden sen^r and James Basden jun^r or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any of personal estate of William Jones dec^d and return the appraisement to the court

An indenture of feoffment between Howell Edmunds jun^r of the one part and Howell Edmunds of the other part And the memorandum of livery of seisin and receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Howell Edmunds jun^r and ordered to be recorded

Benjamin Lewis one of the constables of this county now made return of a warrant for breach of the peace against Charles Mabry on the complaint of Amos Thompson And the said Amos not now appearing It is Ordered that the said Mabry be discharged out of custody

Mary Bass appeared according to her summons and declared she would not take administration on her husbands estate
