An indenture of feoffment between Richard Drake of the one part and
George Williams of the other part was acknowledged by the said Richard
and ordered to be recorded And Sarah the wife of the said Richard
personally appeared in court and being first privately examined as the
Law directs voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the estate
conveyed by the said indenture

Ordered that the road leading formerly to Thristons Ferry from
the fork that leads to Williams bridge be discontinued and that the
same from the said fork to Williams Ferry aforesaid be laid open & kept
in repair as a public road

Complaint being made that Benjamin Holder hath misused Henry
Donald his apprentice It is Ordered that Joseph Gray do enquire into
the circumstances thereof and report to the court
